**European System of Central Banks' Statistics-new challenges, 2010-2015
24 August 2010**

Objectives:

This seminar is aimed at providing participants with a deeper insight into the European System of Central Banks' (ESCB) statistics and the ESCB as both a producer and user of European statistics, the methodology and compilation practices used, the organisation of European statistics production, the core statistics published by the ECB and the development projects over the next five years and beyond.

The seminar will analyse euro area statistics on monetary financial institutions and non-monetary financial corporations used for the conduct of monetary policy as well as statistics required for other, in particular financial stability analysis, purposes. Moreover, it will inform on the integrated sector accounts (including quarterly financial and non-financial accounts), national financial accounts, the Centralised Securities Database and security-by- security reporting and financial stability statistics. There will be a special navigation through the ECB website, to see the latest dynamic graphs and online access to the Statistical Data Warehouse. One presentation will also feature a high-level policy issue: communication and dissemination of central bank statistics. There will be a discussion chaired by the Director General, Statistics, ECB with the opportunity to ask questions related to the future work in improving the ESCB's statistics and to the challenges that lie ahead.
